Moral Character Statement

The New Jersey Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners (Board) licenses dental radiologic technologists in the state of New Jersey. The Board recognizes DANB's Radiation Health & Safety (RHS) examination as its licensing examination in dental radiography.

DANB exam applications contain three Background Information questions that all exam candidates must answer.

These questions require that an exam candidate discloses to DANB if he or she has had any felony convictions (or any crime punishable by confinement in a state or federal prison for any length of time) within the last five years, has ever been disciplined by a regulatory board or credentialing agency, has ever been dismissed by an educational institution for an ethical violation, or has ever been declared mentally incompetent by a court of law. DANB will review each response and make a determination, in consultation with legal counsel, on a case-by-case basis.

The candidate must provide official documentation related to any occurrence, as described in detail on www.danb.org

Following successful completion of the exam, a candidate must complete the NJ Application for License is Limited Dental Radiography which contains the following MORAL CHARACTER STATEMENT:
Have you ever been convicted of any Federal or state crime(s)? Yes No
If yes, please submit official documentation from the court that includes the date(s) of conviction, the name and degree of the crime(s), the court sentence(s) and the status of completing the sentence(s).

Depending on the truthful answers to the questions above, it *may* result in your being denied the privilege of sitting for an exam or *may* result in your being denied the privilege of being granted a NJ Dental Radiologic Technologist license regardless of your performance as a student at IQ Dental Education.
